
PALAZZO RICCI

about Palazzo Ricci it's impossible to isolate the project as a mere real estate development. Palazzo Ricci is much more. Consider how it started. An American businessman, who was previously in business with a British couple who had lived in the area for 20 years, was on holiday in Casoli with his family. He visited the Palazzo Ricci and fell in love with it and Italy.

Immediately he had the idea to bring the palazzo back to life. The idea at the beginning was not immediately clear, maybe it could be a hotel, maybe just some apartments.

But then the heart of the project fell into place: have a lot of people come to Casoli, fall in love with the area too. The countryside is breathtaking, the weather warm, the blue waters of the Adriatic Sea and the mountains, beaches and lakes provide so much entertainment for every age, and this, according to Travel & Leisure, make Abruzzo one of the best destinations to visit.



Therefore, in 2022 the idea of a Private Residence Club with fractional ownership was developed. 14 beautiful residences will be co-owned by 9 owners each, for a total of 126 new families in town.

The locals were very enthusiastic about the restoration and intrigued by the refurbishing works. Palazzo Ricci wanted to make sure from the start of the project that only local professionals were involved.

From the building company based in Vacri, a town forty minutes away from Casoli, that has many years of experience in historical building restorations, to all the technicians working on the electrical and plumbing systems and the businesses providing floors, kitchens, windows and shutters; all are a short drive from Palazzo Ricci.

Also the staff working daily at Palazzo Ricci will be selected locally.


Inclusion and talent
